महोदय/Sir,

मुझे यह कहने का निर्देश हुआ है कि डीसीआई की कार्यकारिणी समिति ने 17.08.2023 को आयोजित अपनी बैठक में नीट परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण किए बिना, बीडीएस स्नातकों के पंजीकरण/ एमडीएस डिग्री की योग्यता जोड़ने के मामले पर विचार किया। नीट यूजी और पीजी स्तर पर सभी दंत शिक्षा संस्थानों के लिए दिनांक 24.05.2016 को लागू हुआ, कुछ राज्यों को छोड़कर, जिन्होंने शैक्षणिक वर्ष 2016-17 के यूजी स्तर के लिए नीट परीक्षा का विकल्प नहीं चुना था (भारत सरकार के पत्र दिनांक 12.07.2017 के अनुसार), राज्य सरकार की सीटों के संबंध में (चाहे सरकारी डेंटल कॉलेज में या निजी डेंटल कॉलेज में)।

I am directed to state that the Executive Committee of the DCI in its meeting held on 17.08.2023 considered the matter of registration of BDS graduates/ add qualification of MDS degree without qualifying the NEET examination. **The NEET came into force on 24.05.2016 for all dental education institutions at UG & PG level, except for some states which have not opted for NEET exam for UG level for the academic year 2016-17 (as per GOI letter dated 12.07.2017) in respect of state government seats (whether in govt. dental college or in a private dental college).**

कार्यकारिणी समिति ने यह भी नोट किया कि शैक्षणिक सत्र 2018-19 से डीसीआई पोर्टल पर छात्रों का विवरण अपलोड करना अनिवार्य कर दिया गया था और शैक्षणिक सत्र 2017-18 तक कॉलेजों द्वारा परिषद में हार्ड कॉपी में प्रस्तुत छात्रों की सूची को भी डीसीआई ने स्वीकार किया था और चर्चा एवं विचार-विमर्श के बाद निम्नानुसार निर्णय लिया गया

The Executive Committee also noted that **uploading the details of students on DCI portal was made mandatory from the academic session 2018-19** and list of students submitted by the colleges in the council in hard copy till the academic session 2017-18 were also accepted by the Council and after discussion & deliberations decided as under:-

All the Registrar of all the State Dental Councils / Tribunals of the country be directed as under:

(i) To ensure the strict compliance that BDS registration is done only after confirming that the applicant has qualified in NEET examination which was enforced for BDS course from academic session 2016-17 (except for some states as per GOI letter dated 12.07.2017) and the same may be ensured at the time of renewal / addition of qualification in respect of MDS / PG Diploma (enforced for PG courses from the academic session 2017-18), including all other requirements and in consonance with DCI's Act & Regulations made thereunder and GOI's letter dated 12.07.2017.

(ii) In case of any dispute/clarification, the matter may be referred with complete facts of the case to this Council for clarification.

(iii) Before any new registration, the State Dental Councils are advised to verify the student's name from the DCI website from the academic session 2018-19. Any letter issued by the Council regarding discharge / non-registration of students should be strictly taken into consideration and in case of any mismatch, the same may be clarified from the Council.

(iv) This is in continuity and further clarification regarding various directions issued by the council vide its letter dated 20.07.2023 regarding registration at State Dental Councils.



The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 4th August, 2016, and is hereby published for general information:—

THE DENTISTS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2016
No. 40 OF 2016

[4th August, 2016.]

An Act further to amend the Dentists Act, 1948.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 2016.
- (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on 24th May, 2016.

16 of 1948.

2. After section 10C of the Dentists Act, 1948 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), the following section shall be inserted, namely:—

“10D. There shall be conducted a uniform entrance examination to all dental educational institutions at the undergraduate level and post-graduate level through such designated authority in Hindi, English and such other languages and in such manner as may be prescribed and the designated authority shall ensure the conduct of uniform entrance examination in the aforesaid manner:

Provided that notwithstanding any judgment or order of any court, the provisions of this section shall not apply, in relation to the uniform entrance examination at the undergraduate level for the academic year 2016-17 conducted in accordance with any regulations made under this Act, in respect of the State Government seats (whether in Government Dental College or in a private Dental College) where such State has not opted for such examination.”

Short title and commencement

Insertion of new section 10D. Uniform entrance examination for undergraduate and post-graduate level.

Amendment
of section 20.

3. In section 20 of the principal Act, after clause (h), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(hi) the designated authority, other languages and the manner of conducting of uniform entrance examination to all dental educational institutions at the undergraduate level and post-graduate level;”.

Repeal and
savings.

4. (1) The Dentists (Amendment) Ordinance, 2016 is hereby repealed.

Ord. 5 of
2016.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the Dentists Act, 1948 as amended by the said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of the said Act, as amended by this Act.
